How To Get There:

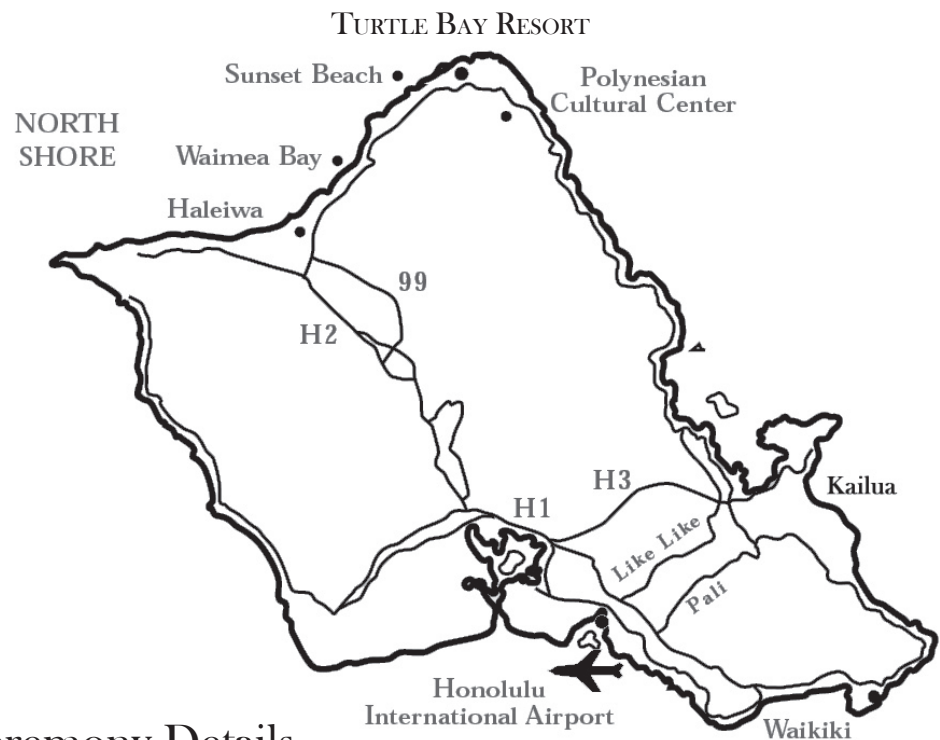

Turtle Bay is located on the North Shore of Oahu. Plan for an hour and fifteen minutes of travel time from the Honolulu/Waikiki area. Hosted parking will be provided at the resort.

- For those who prefer not to drive, buses will be provided from a central location in Waikiki (please let us know where you are staying). Further details about bussing will be communicated over email and on the website (www.saracino.com/wedding).

Directions from Airport, Waikiki:

Take H1 Freeway, Westbound. You will stay on the H1 Freeway for approximately six miles. Look for signs for the H2 Freeway, Northbound (North Shore/Wahiawa). Merge right onto the H2 Freeway. Continue on the H2 Freeway North to Wahiawa. Exit at Wahiawa (Exit 8) on to 80 (Kamehameha Hwy) through Wahiawa. Continue Northbound, 80 connects with 99. Stay on 99 to Haleiwa. The road now bypasses Haleiwa and becomes route 83. Continue on 83 approximately 20 minutes toward Kahuku. Turtle Bay Resort will be on the left hand side. Park near hotel and enter through main lobby.



Ceremony Details

Location: Kuilima Point, grassy area at the northernmost tip of the resort

Time: 5:00 pm

What to wear: Cocktail or Aloha attire
(Suits or aloha shirts for men, cocktail/party dresses for women)

Reception Details

Location: Kuilima Ballroom, steps away from the ceremony

Time: Immediately following the ceremony – midnight
